2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

3. MATTERS ARISING

World Squash Day Squashathon is going ahead overnight from 8pm on the 11th to 8am on the 12th with good support to date

- Currently 7 teams of 4 entered.

Extended bar hours during the Rugby World Cup

- Current opening bar hours are from midday extended licence possible, needs application to go in 2 weeks before the required event and costs £28/licence.
- 9am on the 12th there is a rugby match (following the Squashathon) will apply for a licence for this day. Looking to extend the bar hours for this day. Will consider popular opinion at the bar regarding matches on other days.

Winners boards – committee are still considering options for new winners boards for the bar area.

Fire visit – keyholders in the process of being updated (NK looking after)

Vending machine – removal is in process, will be gone from c. late September

4. OFFICERS' REPORTS

<u>A – CHAIRMAN</u>

AGM pre meeting - PB and MB met with Chris Langford.

- £4,700 fund available (plus £1,200 each year from Fullers) for the encouragement of new squash players to come through. Tring already run a numbers of events to encourage new players – adult coaching, juniors at Tring School etc. Committee considered options for how the fund should be allocated amongst members
 - Committee agreed that the following suggestions the would be appropriate:

- subsidies for follow on coaching sessions from the 6 week free sessions for players who join as members
- Cap junior coaching prices at the current level, with subsidies to cover additional costs
- Other suggestions, including guiding principals for how to spend the money to be considered.

BT – has been renewed for a further year

Pendley – car park management system is now operational.

<u>B – TREASURER</u>

PB presented the draft annual accounts to the committee. Final accounts will be sent to members ahead of the AGM.

- Cash in bank up £25k to £150k
- Net profit of £21k, due to
 - Increase in bar sales of £2k to £68k
 - Gross Margin down 0.5% due to bar prices remaining the same, but bar costs increasing
 - Court bookings and tournament fees increase of £7k, partly due to an artificial increase in paypal drawdowns (£5.5k of which was drawdown in this financial year, but related to court bookings during the last financial year)
 - Subscriptions and entry fees also up £7.5k, partly due to the increase in fees but there was also a £2.5k increase in subscriptions yoy during the first 6 months of the year.
 - Coaching income up £1k
 - Expenditure decreases
 - No volunteers event held this year (bi-annual event)
 - £2k less in maintenance and repairs
 - Booking system costs up £3.5k due to equipment costs for the new MMM system

C – MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY

PA welcomed as the new Membership Secretary.

c.450 members at the current time (currently 421 in MMM).

D – SECRETARY

5. TEAM REPORTS:

<u>Men's Captain</u> – Racketball – 2 teams in the Bucks league. 1st team finished 6th in the 1st div second team finished 4th in the 2nd div. Completed all the fixtures. Squash men's summer team came second, just missing out by a couple of points.

New winter squash team -3 men's teams registered in Div 1, Div 2, and Div 3. Alex Preston will be running the 1st team (Thurs nights), KW running the second team (Tuesday nights) and MD running the 3rd team (now Wed nights).

Ladies' Captain – No ladies matches over the summer. We will be entering the ladies 1^{st} team into the Herts Ladies league and the Bucks Div 1, and the ladies 2^{nd} team into the Bucks div 2 again this year.

Women's Squash week 23-29th September. The events that Tring is holding will be covered under AOB.

<u>**House**</u> – Court maintenance work underway and installation of 17" tins for the PSA tournament (with removable batons)

Shower pressure issues – limited by the external pressure coming in. AP to phone the water board understand if there are any issues. To be considered as part of the development plan.

Security issues – there has been regular occurrences where the committee room external doors or the fire escape external doors have been opened and left opened overnight. **Committee urged members to ensure that if they open doors, they shut the doors when they leave.** Additionally there have been occasions where the bar has been left opened when it shouldn't. MB to consider options for keeping the bar keys including speaking to John Kettle and security options using MMM fobs.
