2. MATTERS ARISING

Welfare issues – The sub-committee will comprise of Mark Bullard, Joni Duncan, Anthony Palmer & Jon Slade. In addition the sub-committee will speak to those involved in coaching at the club for their input before anything is agreed. The subcommittee will meet shortly.

The committee elected reviewed options for electricity supply and selected by majority vote, a package that fixed our costs with EON for 3 years.
